Tuesday, 18 November, 2025

Day 9 of the COP builds momentum for the structural shifts needed to safeguard nature while strengthening resilience for people on the frontlines of climate impacts. The high-level segment continued today, including a number of high-level ministerial events. Delivering Ocean Commitments highlighted progress on the Blue NDC Challenge and the role of ocean-based solutions in implementing the First Global Stocktake. The Bridging Action Agendas from COP16 to COP30 roundtable discussed advancing synergies across climate, land and biodiversity frameworks, reinforcing the need for integrated restoration and conservation efforts. Additional highlights included the launch of the NAP Implementation Alliance, a new multi-actor platform developed as part of the COP30 Action Agenda, and the Global Ethical Stocktake, emphasizing the need for fairness, collaboration and shared responsibility.

Education for Empowerment: Shaping the Next Generation of Climate Innovators



This panel explored the critical role of North American higher education in accelerating ambitious climate action, aligning with SDG 4 (Quality Education) and the Paris Agreement. Higher education is an essential partner in fulfilling the Paris Agreement's call to "enhance climate change education, training, public awareness, public participation and public access to information". This discussion featured faculty experts and student leaders from different institutions, highlighting innovative programming, educational experiences, and interdisciplinary initiatives across a range of contexts. The panel also discussed the impacts these educational approaches have in fostering student agency, building trust between stakeholders, and accelerating the transition to a sustainable society.
