

Partnership with South Church Andover

Project Overview

In 2017, Habitat joined forces with Andover Community Trust and South Church in Andover to transform 1.06 acres of unused land into a vibrant community of six affordable homes.



Habitat and Church Partnership

Habitat partnered with South Church to take on as much of the predevelopment work as they could under the church's guidance. Following a successful congregational vote, the church took a bold step of faith in 2019, selling their land to Habitat for Humanity for \$200,000, \$83,200 below market value.

Legacy and Impact

As a result of this partnership, six income-eligible families now own homes in Andover and are educating their children in Andover Schools. South Church made housing possible while advancing their own reputation as a leader and furthering their mission to create a more equitable and just community.
